A. Koutsouradis, Permission for an alien, who is a candidate for political asylum, to enter into a civil marriage according to article 1368 of the Civil Code (Comments with reference to Decision number 6459/2009 of the Single Member Court of First Instance of Athens) 15

Abstract: Decision No 6459/2009 of the Single-Judge Athens Court of First Instance granted marriage permit to an alien applicant for asylum after the application has been rejected by the competent mayor. The decision receives positive comments in this study. Attempting an interpretation of the provisions of Presidential Decree No 391/1982 in order to emulate citizens and foreigners, it is noted that the desire for marriage can not be ruled out for any reason, since while civil law recognizes as basic principle the freedom of marriage, the Constitution as well as the ECHR recognize a fundamental right to marry, which does not tolerate limitations. Finally it is noted that restrictions result not even from the Geneva Convention on the Status of Refugees.

H. Konstantakopoulos, Judicial Expulsion. 20

Abstract: This study attempts to present the legal nature of the judicial deportation order as compulsory departure of a person of foreign nationality from the borders of the Hellenic territory; the formal and substantial prerequisites of legal enforcement, the deportation for EU citizens and prohibitions of enforcement, the issues related to the detention of the subject to be deported as well as topics relevant to the initiation, length and execution of the order.

E. Poularakis, Judicial protection for aliens awaiting administrative expulsion 29

Abstract: This study attempts to present the current legal frame for the judicial protection applied to foreign nationals subject to administrative deportation, according to law regarding foreigners (Law No 3386/2005) and highlights the major doctrinal and procedural problems that emerge at the enforcement of the relevant provisions. At the outset, the prerequisites and the deportation procedure in general are depicted, subsequently the means of judicial protection are reported in brief, that is, the objections against detention, the cancellation request and the suspension of the deportation judgment.

Ev. Stavroulaki, Issuance, renewal and revocation of special identification card for expatriates with Albanian nationality 47

Abstract: For the Albanian nationals of Greek origin who wish to come to Greece and legalize their presence, legislation includes some

ad hoc beneficial provisions and preferential treatment compared to foreigners of other nationalities. However, their presence may become undesirable, due to reasons pertaining to public order and national security, thus reserving for them the same treatment provided for any other foreigner who has been judged as dangerous for the public order.

Abstract: Adoption of under-aged and adult foreigners by Greek citizens - The applicable provisions of the Civil Code and the Code of Civil Procedure - Major topics related to the procedure - Evolution of the Case law - The possibility of naturalization.
